- \$50 Fee for 10' x 10' space (on grass)
- Vendors are responsible for providing their own tents, tables and chairs.
- Electricity - 20 volt/20 amp service available. Vendors must provide their own 100 foot outdoor extension cords.
- We encourage you to apply early as registrations will be handled on a first come, first served basis. We will limit vendors with "like products" as determined by the Arts, Craft & Gift Fair Committee.
- Upon acceptance of your application, an invoice will be emailed to you.
- Event will take place rain or shine. There are no refunds due to weather.
- Hours of Arts, Craft & Gift Fair will be posted as: (vendors may be open longer at their discretion)
Friday: 5:00 PM-7:30 PM; Saturday 10:00 AM-7:30 PM; Sunday: Following Parade-4:00 PM
- Setup between 9:00 AM and 3:00 PM on Friday. (No setup is allowed on Thursday.)
- Parking - You will receive ONE parking pass which must be displayed on vehicle dashboard.
- Security will be on duty in Spooner Park overnight on Friday and Saturday, however, vendor is responsible for any loss or damage to merchandise or equipment.
